Find out about an astronaut of your choice. Who are they? Where did they travel? Why did you pick them? What have you found out about them? Write this into an information leaflet.	Imagine you are an astronaut. Write a diary entry about a day you've spent on the moon. Did you meet any space creatures? Did you find any moon rocks? Did you have an adventure?	Can you draw the front cover of your favourite book about space. Is the story fiction or non-fiction? Why is it your favourite? Are there characters in the story? Where in space the story set?
