The percentage of pupils achieving expected outcomes at the end of Key Stage 1 has improved from last year and is in line with National average in reading and writing and above National and LAT average for maths. The percentage achieving greater depth has increased in all areas from last year.

If we look at 'Home Grown' children there is a significant difference in all areas from 'Not Home Grown'.

**Year 1 and 2 Phonics**

Year 1 phonics results increased this year and were above both LAT and National averages. In year 2 the % passing the phonics screening was broadly in line with the LAT and National average.

The proportion of children achieving a good level of development at the end of the EYFS was in line with the LAT average and a significant improvement on COPA's 2018 results.

Almost 10% of children in 2019 reached an exceeding level in writing, compared to no exceeding writers in 2018. Children show enjoyment in writing for a range of purposes and are confident to have a go and work through their mistakes.

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
