

COPA School Uniform

At Cherry Orchard, we have a very smart school uniform and we are very proud to see most of our children wearing the correct uniform with pride.

However, some children are still wearing some incorrect items such as polo shirts/blouses instead of collared shirts, no ties and incorrect footwear and hair ribbons. During this term, we will be focussing on correct uniform and Teachers will be issuing green slips to give parents the opportunity to rectify any incorrect items of school uniform.

We are aware that some younger children struggle with the current school clip tie, so we are liaising with Brigade to see if we can offer elastic ties for younger children and proper ties for the older children. We will notify parents when we have more information. Ties should be worn throughout the duration of the school day and should **not** be removed except for PE Lessons. This also avoids them getting mislaid. All items of uniform should be clearly labelled with your child's name; we have several expensive jumpers and ties in the lost property box, that cannot be returned to the owner because they are unnamed.

No long boots or trainers are allowed during the school day and all shoes should be sturdy, sensible and black in colour. Hair ribbons/bows should be appropriate in size and in line with school colours or black/white. - White collared button shirt
- Grey school trousers
- Green jumper (red stripe & logo)
- Green/Red stripe tie
- Grey socks
- Black sensible shoes
- Green Fleece with logo

- Green Shorts
- Grey Jogging bottoms (*optional*)
- Black plimsolls or trainers
